Minutes of 6 January 2025

The Minutes of 6 January 2025 were agreed as a correct record.

Draft Regulation 14 Plan

Subject to more clearly differentiating local green spaces within Rock and Rennington the amended version of the Draft Plan was agreed.

The Group noted that work on non-designated heritage assets was yet to be completed. Once this element was finalised the next steps would be proof-reading the Draft Plan followed by resolving any remaining layout issues to improve the look and feel of the document.

Looking ahead to the next round of consultation the Group confirmed the need to produce a much more concise version for distribution to all residents. The content of this document would need to be discussed and agreed at a future meeting.

Non-designated Heritage Assets

Following on from the discussions at the January meeting, the debate focussed on the two drafts that had been circulated with the agenda. It was finally agreed that the list of heritage assets should now be extended to include all three buildings on the west side of Rennington Green as well as the Mill House (but not the Mill Race nor Millpond).

Alan offered to consult with George; Ruth with Ken; Tony with Laurence and Stephen with the Horseshoes.

Stephen also undertook to liaise with Ruth to develop and then circulate a revised draft relating to non-designated heritage assets for discussion and agreement at the next meeting

Industrial Estates

The Group agreed that there would be value in incorporating within the Draft Plan some information on each of the three industrial estates within the parish.
